Tomlanovich-Dimond Equity Research Fund

Each year two research teams comprised of a faculty member and undergraduate student are awarded \$10,000 (\$5,000 for the faculty member and \$5,000 for the undergraduate student) to support work that builds upon the vision of the WLI to advance leadership equity for women globally.
