4. Call for Proposals – Peacebuilding/Peacemaking

The Research Committee discussed and identified the criteria for the upcoming Call for Proposals on Peacebuilding/Peacemaking. The mini-grants will be for

\$10,000. A match of \$1,000 (or 10% if the budget is less than \$10,000) is required but that is the sum of any contributions from units or colleges. The Lead PI or one Co-PI should be from the College of Social Science. Cross-unit and cross-college research teams and applications will be encouraged. Proposals can focus on domestic or international sites and may be historical, theoretical, applied or tests of interventions. Social Science researchers who have received College funding in the past three years are not eligible.
