COMMON JOB TYPES

- Museum Technician & Conservator Restore, maintain, or prepare objects in museum collections for storage, research, or exhibit.
- **Archivist** Appraise, edit, and direct safekeeping of permanent records and historically valuable documents.
- **Curator** Administer collections, such as artwork, collectibles, historic items, or scientific specimens of museums or other institutions.
- Data Transcriber Operate data entry device, locate and correct data entry errors, verify the accuracy of data.
- Anthropologist Research, evaluate, and establish public policy concerning the origins of humans; their physical, social, linguistic, and cultural development; and behavior.
- **Research Assistant** Assist in laboratory, survey, and other research. May help prepare findings for publication and assist in analysis, quality control, or data management.
