COMMON JOB TYPES

- **Court Clerk** Perform clerical duties in courts of law; prepare dockets of cases to be called; secure information for judges; contact witnesses, attorneys, and litigants.
- **Fundraiser** Organize activities to raise funds or otherwise solicit and gather monetary donations or other gifts for an organization.
- **Public Relations Specialist** Engage in promoting or creating an intended public image for individuals, groups, or organizations.
- **Research Assistant** Assist social scientists in laboratory, survey, and other social science research. May help prepare findings for publication and assist in laboratory analysis, quality control, or data management.
- Social & Community Service Manager Plan, direct, or coordinate the activities of a social service program or community outreach organization. Work may involve directing social workers, counselors, or probation officers.
- Social & Human Service Assistant Assist clients in identifying and obtaining available benefits and social and community services.
