An Urban and Regional Planning (URP) major develops an understanding of modern cities, as well as the social, historical, political, economic, and cultural forces shaping urban areas. Students gain a background in community economic development, environmental stewardship and sustainability, and an understanding of how to plan for transportation, health, housing, and real estate in a global context.

URP majors go on to work in a variety of industries, including:

COMMON JOB TYPES

- **City & Regional Planning Aide** Compile data from sources like maps, reports, and field and file investigations for city planners' use.
- Emergency Management Director/Planner Plan and direct disaster response for crisis management; provide disaster prep training; and prepare emergency plans and procedures for natural, wartime, or technological disasters, or hostage situations.
- **Transportation Planner** Prepare information for proposed transportation projects by gathering, analyzing, and compiling data. Also, study the use and operation of transportation systems and develop transportation models or simulations.
- **Real Estate Appraiser** Appraise property to determine its purchase value or sale price for investment, mortgage, or loan purposes.
